GULFPORT, MS - Light winds early and a building breeze in the Mississippi Sound favored the faster-rated boats in the 2014 edition of the Race to the Coast. Ken Yeoman's PERFIDIA was second in Div B.

HOT CHOCOLATE, Casey Grimm, took third in Div B.
